1 FOREWORD BY THE MANAGING DIRECTOR

The year 2014 marked the 50th anniversary of the South African Agency for Science and Technology Advancement's (SAASTA's) National Science Olympiad (NSO). The NSO is a competition that aims to contribute towards excellence in science among learners and to encourage them to take up careers in Science, Engineering and Technology (SET). This, it is hoped would increase the human capital in these critical areas to enable South Africa to be economically competitive and a leader in science and innovation in Africa and globally. SAASTA has led this drive since 1964.

To celebrate this important milestone, SAASTA launched a celebratory book, titled **Nurturing SET talent through the National Science Olympiad**, on 10 July 2014. During her keynote address at the launch of the book and the NSO Awards Ceremony last year, the Minister of Department of Science and Technology (DST) Mrs Naledi Pandor said: "It's remarkable to note that this is the 50th year of the Olympiad. It's remarkable enough on its own, but the Olympiad is much more than a science and biology exam competition. It's the jewel in the crown of our Youth into Science strategy, which is all about identifying and nurturing talent. The Olympiad also identifies talent. It identifies talent that teachers have nurtured in schools across the length and breadth of the country."

As an organisation we believe that science is the gateway subject to the world around us. Its application is in everything we do, see, touch, use, feel and smell. There is no limit when it comes to science and how it affects our daily lives. Through the NSO, we have had many achievements in identifying and nurturing talent into influential careers and contributing to the economy of South Africa. Some of the participants in the NSO over the years include Prof Nithaya Chetty (National Research Foundation's Group Executive for Astronomy), Mr Mteto Nyati (MD of Microsoft South Africa), Imraan Coovadia (award winning poet), Prof Tshilidzi Marwali (Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Post Graduate Studies and Library at the University of Johannesburg and the youngest recipient of the Order of Mapungubye) and Dr Thuthula Balfour-Kaipa (Head of Health for the Chamber of Mines).

I am very proud to look back at our record. We have taken young people from all walks of life across the country and helped create opportunities for them to be the best in what they do and to be assets for the country and the world. To see the influence that the NSO has had in the lives of past participants fills me with immense joy. However, we acknowledge that more work still needs to be done to further grow our reach and influence particularly on the new generation.

We all need to join hands to further identify and nurture the next generation of innovators, scientists and researchers. We need to create endless possibilities for our youth that a solid school-level foundation in Science and Mathematics can offer in terms of career choices. The NSO is an ideal example of how the government and the business sector can work together on identifying and nurturing talent, and thus contribute to the economy of the country and a better South Africa. 2 ABOUT THE NATIONAL RESEARCH FOUNDATION (NRF)

The National Research Foundation was established through the National Research Foundation Act (Act No 23 of 1998). The objective of the National Research Foundation (NRF) is to support and promote research through funding, human capacity development and the provision of the necessary research facilities, in order to facilitate the creation of knowledge, innovation and development in all fields of the natural and social sciences, humanities and technology, including indigenous knowledge systems.

To enable the NRF to deliver on its mandate, the organisation has three main functions:

- to support research and innovation through its agency, Research and Innovation Support and Advancement (RISA);
- to encourage an interest in science and technology through its business unit, the South African Agency for Science and Technology Advancement (SAASTA);
- and to facilitate high-end research through its National Research Facilities.

3 NATIONAL SCIENCE OLYMPIAD

3.1. Programme Brief

Science Olympiads are used internationally as a means of promoting science and excellence in science. SAASTA's National Science Olympiad not only contributes towards excellence in science, but has huge potential in expanding participation levels of previously excluded groups and simultaneously building the capability in the sciences.

SAASTA's National Science Olympiad is a project that was started in 1964, initially for grade 12 learners with the objective of promoting science. Now in its 51st year, the competition continues to be one of SAASTA's flagship projects. Since 2005, the project has been offering learners in grade 10 to 12 an exciting opportunity to compete and interact in the science arena with fellow learners from all nine provinces in South Africa, Southern African Development Community (SADC) countries such as Lesotho, Namibia and Zimbabwe and also their counterparts in Australia.

The competition is an annual written examination comprising of two papers/streams: Physical Science (Physics and Chemistry) and Life Science (Biology). Learners can choose in which stream they want to compete and their schools enter them accordingly. The top performing learners and schools are then awarded based on excellence. The top national performers from several categories also stand a chance of receiving an all-expenses-paid trip to the London International Youth Science Forum and the Australian National Science Focus Week.

The main focus of the competition is to encourage excellence in science education and to stimulate interest in the sciences. It further seeks to inspire young people to consider careers in science, engineering and technology (SET).

To ensure that talent in SET is identified and nurtured, a group of 120 learners who excelled or demonstrated potential during the Olympiad examination are traditionally invited to participate in a Science Focus Week during the July school holidays. The activities consist of stimulating lectures, excursions, relevant industry visits and other fun events. This culminates into a high profile Awards Ceremony where prizes are awarded to deserving learners and schools.

3.2. Milestones

Over the years, a number of milestones were achieved through the National Science Olympiad, in particular:

- A major three-year sponsorship was secured from Harmony Gold Mining Company in 2009 which was later renewed for two consecutive years
- Through the Federation for Engineering, Science and Technology Olympiad and Competitions (FESTOC), the Department of Science and Technology (DST) provides SAASTA with funding to increase the participation of Dinaledi Schools by settling the entry fees on their behalf.

4 CRITERIA FOR AWARDING CERTIFICATES

Learners who obtained at least 40% in either the Physical Science or Life Science paper will each receive an achievement or participation certificate based on their mark.

5 2015 PRIZES AND AWARDS

In 2015, over 30 prizes/awards were given to deserving schools and learners in different categories. The main categories are as follows:

- Top Learners from SADC Countries (excluding South Africa) per stream
- Learners attending the London International Youth Science Forum
- Learner attending the Australian National Science Focus Week
